Known for its inconsistentness, baroque music includes the use of basso continuo, degree of decoration, self-expression, open form, and the formation of counterpoints. Think of the Baroque era as a funnel that collected all forms of music and ideas. Over time, the channel becomes smaller through testing and errors. Popular baroque music ideas are chosen and explained, then further researched and expanded. Fewer popular ideas fall by the roadside. Each passing year is a step closer to the classical period, where the rules of composition have become perfected and the order reigns supreme. Amidst the chaotic sea of baroque music, there are hundreds of works that shine like beacons in the night. Yo Yo Ma performs Bach's 6 Suites for Unaccompanied Cello. The record won the Grammy Award for Best Musical Instrument Reed in 1985. Sony It is largely believed that Johann Sebastian Bach composed six sets for the cello between 1717 and 1723. The manuscript belonged to his second wife, Anna Magdalena Bach, titled Suites à Violoncello Solo senza Basso. These works are instantly recognizable, and perhaps, the most famous music ever written for solo cello. The suites are very popular, they have been pronounced for many different tools. The concertos are said to be the boldest program music ever written during the baroque period (music composed to describe a story). George Frideric Handel composed the Messiah after his friend and playw writer, Charles Jennens, expressed in a letter his desire to create a biblical cho cho chow set for music in 1741. They intended the Messiah to be performed at Easter, but it found its home at Christmas instead. Throughout the work, Handel uses excellent painting text, a technique by which musical notes mimic lines of text. Pieter-Jan Belder performs Domenico Scarlatti's complete sonata harpsichord. Brilliant Classics Domenico Scarlatti, son of Alessandro Scarlatti (a famous baroque composer), wrote 555 famous harpsichord sonatas, of which more than half were written in the last six years of his life. His career entered the early classical period, and his sonatas influenced many classical composers after him. 12 Concerti Gross - Performed by The English Concert with Conductor, Trevor Pinnock. Produktion Produktion Archive Corelli's twelve concerti grossi is a perfect example of grosso concerto of the baroque era (the musical form is like a musical dialogue between large orchestras and small groups of reed artists). Concertos are one of the most performed concertos in the world; Their happy and upbeat nature easily inspires and stimulates listeners of all nationalities. Henry Purcell of Opera. Dido and Aeneas. The opera by Philips Henry Purcell. Dido and Aeneas, was the first opera by the British composer. It was also his entirely singable dramatic work, having written several staged works before and after the premiere. The opera is a great example of baroque-era opera. Giovanni Battista Sammartini - The Complete Early Symphonies. The Era of Nuova Giovanni Battista Sammartini was considered the initiation of classical forms of symphony (especially sonata form), and many believed that his thematic comedies and developments were a forewarned of the symphonies written by Haydn and Mozart. Paris Quartet. Sony Classical Georg Philipp Telemann is one of the most prolific composers of the Baroque period. Unlike other famous composers, Telemann's musical abilities are largely self-learning. The combination of unusual instruments in his concerto was one of the things that made him unique. For example, his famous Parisian quartet was recorded for flute, violin, viola da gamba, and continuo. Agnus Dei - Oxford New College Choir. Erato Disques Gregorio Allegri composed this sacred work in the 1630s, under Pope Urban VIII. The work was written for use in the Tenebrae service on Holy Wednesday and Good Friday. Pope Urban VIII loved the work, until he banned it from being done elsewhere outside the Sistine Chapel. For 100 years, it has been done exclusively at the church.
